



1. **More London** URBED provide public liaison for More London. We were originally involved in community consultation prior to the masterplanning application. The site includes the City Hall, the home of the GLA.
2. **Sustaining the Essence of Northcote Road** URBED undertook a trader's survey, family, market traders and evening economy focus groups for sustaining Northcote Road as a special place.
3. **Gloucester Creative Quarter** We organised a roundtable event to bring together community stakeholders to discuss the development of a creative quarter in the city centre.
4. **Brighton New England Quarter** URBED liaised with community groups (who were initially very hostile to development),

ran consultations with local businesses, and helped set up and participated on a working party with the Council to agree a development brief.

5. **Vision for Leeds** A visioning exercise for Leeds involving a series of seven round table conferences which brought over 700 people together, many for the first time.
6. **Business-Led Regeneration** The project included four community consultation workshops in Gateshead, Haringey, Leicester and Sheffield as part of the Business-Led Regeneration project for the DTI and ODPM.
7. **Partners in Urban Renaissance** A series of focus groups, run with MORI, on issues regarding public spaces and places as part of the 24 Towns and Cities Initiative.
