



# Regeneration

1. **Oldham Beyond** A major study to develop a vision for the borough of Oldham including masterplans for the town centre and the Housing Market Renewal area.
2. **Newcastle Grainger Town** The *Investing in Quality* and *Living in Quality* handbooks are helping to attract private investment into this historic quarter.
3. **Ancoats, Manchester** A delivery plan for the Urban Village Company to reconcile regeneration and heritage objectives.
4. **London Fields, Hackney** The resolution of conflict between Hackney Council and a squatters group led to the successful development of a live/work scheme.
5. **Gloucester Creative Quarter** URBED was commissioned to advise on the feasibility of creating a creative quarter out of two of the oldest sets of buildings in the country. Working with Comedia, we used consultations and lessons from comparable places to devise the strategy.
6. **Little Germany, Bradford** URBED led a BURA Awards winning Action Team in this historic textile quarter, including setting up the Bradford Design Exchange.
7. **Merton Abbey Mills, Colliers Wood** The refurbishment of the former Liberty Silk printing mills in South London as a riverside venue and craft market.

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URBED has long pioneered the ideas of urban regeneration and the reuse of vacant sites and buildings. We have a track record for seeing opportunities when the market can only see the problems, and have put together a host of successful projects, a number of which have won awards, from organisations such as BURA. Experience of reusing industrial buildings and urban waterfronts has been disseminated through good practice guides, and Regeneration Through Heritage.
